

FACTS**WHAT DOES METRO FORD
DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> n Social Security number and income n Credit history and Credit Scores n Account Balances and Payment History When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customer's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer's personal information; the reasons Metro Ford chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Metro Ford protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Metro Ford collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> n apply for financing n give us your income information or provide employment information n provide account information or give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> n sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your credit worthiness n affiliates from using your information to market you n sharing for nonaffiliates' to market you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. n <i>Metro Ford does not share with affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. n <i>Metro Ford does not share with non affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. n <i>Metro Ford does not joint market.</i>
